



Calf hut hygiene (Cryptosporidiosis prevention)

1 Remove all removable equipment

- Take away all the removable equipment (buckets etc.) and clean and disinfect them according the protocol described below.
- Goal: everything that came into contact with the calves should be disinfected.



2 Dry cleaning

- Removal of manure, litter, feed residues
- Goal: increases efficacy of the main cleaning



3 Apply detergent

- Foam with 1-1,5% Kenosan, allow 0,3L solution/m²
- Minimum 15-30 minutes contact time
- Goal: foam enhances the contact time of the detergent into the surface, which increases the efficiency of the cleaning

Calf hut hygiene (Cryptosporidiosis prevention)

4 Main cleaning

- High pressure: mechanical cleaning (50-150 bar and 12-30 Litres/min.)
- All surfaces: walls, floors, feeders, ceiling,...

Hot water (40°):
+ Faster and easier



5 Anti parasitic disinfection

- Spray or foam with 2-4% KENOCOX, allow 0,4L solution/m²
- Minimum 2 hours contact time
- Rinse buckets before using them again
